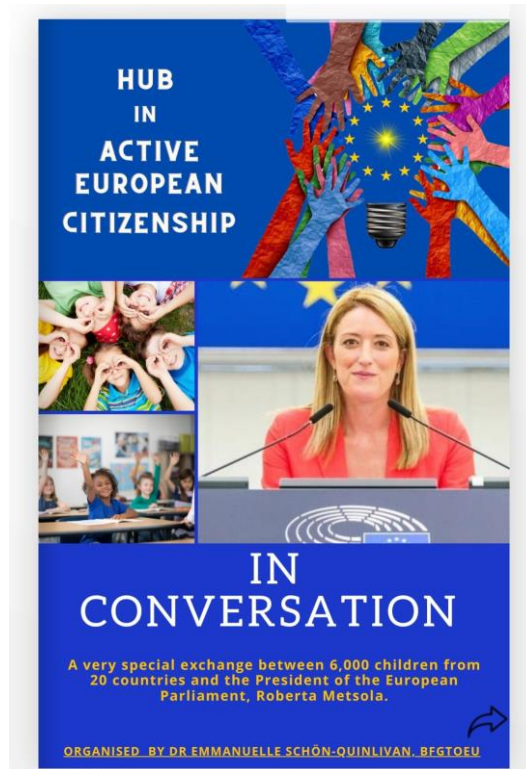


News Item: Jean Monnet for schools
